**MEMBERSHIP INTAKE POLICY**  
**Adopted 2/6/13**

The Multicultural Greek Council is committed to growing by quality over quantity. The goal of the Membership Intake Policy is to encourage member organizations to follow University and inter/national membership intake policies.

The MGC at OSU expects all member organizations to abide by their inter/national organization's membership intake policies and to follow the MGC at OSU membership intake policies listed below:

- a) Member organizations are encouraged to conduct membership intake at least once per year.
- b) Member organizations are reminded that it is University policy that no required events take place during pre-finals and finals week. This includes intake, new member/neophyte education, and ritual events.
- c) Member organizations are encouraged not to induct or consider first semester freshmen until a University GPA is established.
- d) Member organizations shall abide by their inter/national organization's GPA requirement for individuals being inducted.
- e) Member organizations shall abide by University, MGC at OSU and their inter/national organization's hazing policies.
- f) Member organizations shall invite a staff member of the Office of Fraternity & Sorority Affairs to a gathering, preferably an informational session, of prospective members. All new members/neophytes must be educated on the topic of hazing in order to be listed on a member organization's official roll.

Violations of this Code of Ethics will result in judicial proceedings through a judicial board hearing or through the Office of Student Conduct Education and Administration.
