9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENTS OF OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:**

11 **SECTION 1:** The purpose of this bill is to allocate \$1000 to the **ASIAN AMERICAN**
12 **STUDENT ASSOCIATION** hereafter, “the student organization.”
13

14 **SECTION 2:** The SGA Treasurer is hereby directed to transfer a total of \$1000, as outlined
15 above, from the SGA Co-Sponsorship Account (Account #AA- -) into
16 the account of the student organization (**Account # AA- -**).

18 **SECTION 3:** The SGA Treasurer shall report to the SGA Senate on the results of the
19 appropriations.

21 **SECTION 4:** The student organization shall publicize SGA’s Co-Sponsorship in advertising and
22 promotional materials for said event.

24 **SECTION 5:** The student organization shall return all co-sponsorship funds not used and
25 provide a written report to the SGA Budget Committee within 30 days of using
26 the allocation.

10 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENTS OF OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:**

12 **SECTION 1: Title I Section 8.6 shall read as follows:**
13

14 8.5. REPORTING - All Standing Committees shall be required to give a report at every
15 regular Senate meeting concerning committee meetings, committee work, and committee
16 proposed legislation.

17 8.6 All committees ~~(except the Student Commission Alliance Committee, which shall~~
18 ~~meet twice monthly)~~ shall meet weekly ~~regardless of whether legislation has been~~
19 ~~forwarded to the committee at the discretion of the committee chair.~~

20 8.6.1 A committee chair will be assigned one (1) absence, at the discretion of the
21 Senate Chair, every time he or she fails to hold a regularly-scheduled committee
22 meeting.

14 **Sec. 2 Automatic Seats**

- 15 2.1 When a student group is selected to use the student suite, they will be given 6 seats.
16 2.2 For the purposes of the student lottery, 3 pairs of SGA Student Suite tickets shall be
17 allocated towards the drawing.
18 2.3 The remaining 6 seats shall be given to:
19 2.3.1 The SGA President
20 2.3.2 The SGA Senate Chair
21 2.3.3 The SGA Vice President or, in their absence, one member of the
22 Executive Branch
23 2.3.4 One Senator
24 2.3.5 The SGA Advisor plus one guest
25

26 **Sec. 4 Student Lottery**

- 27 4.1 Rules for Participation
28 4.1.1 Entrants shall provide a copy of their class schedule, OSU email and
29 telephone number, via email to the PR Director and the SGA President.
30 4.1.2 All winners selected to be in the student suite shall be required to sign a
31 behavioral contract. If this contract is violated, said winner(s) shall be
32 asked to leave by an SGA officer immediately.
33 4.2 Rules for Operation:
34 4.2.1 For each home football game, 3 pairs of SGA Student Suite tickets shall
35 be distributed to 3 entrants who shall be chosen via random drawing.
36 4.2.1.1 Each winner shall be permitted to select one other full-time OSU-
37 Stillwater student to accompany them as a guest.
38 4.2.2 Entries shall be accepted the week before the game from 9:00 a.m. on
39 Monday until 5:00 p.m. on Friday. The PR Director will have discretion to
40 find a fair medium to find students. Social media (twitter, Instagram, or
41 Facebook) are viable and preferable methods of finding students for the
42 lottery.
43 4.2.3 The SGA President ~~and SGA Senate Chair~~ shall meet on Monday the
44 week of the game to administer the drawing, and shall contact the winners
45 immediately thereafter.

1 4.2.4 Potential winners shall have until Wednesday at 5 p.m. to claim the
2 tickets.

3 4.2.4.1 Upon claiming tickets, both the potential winner and guest shall be
4 required to appear in person and present a valid photo I.D. The
5 guest shall also bring a copy of his/her class schedule so that
6 enrollment may be confirmed.

7 4.2.5 If a potential winner fails to claim the tickets in the time allowed, cannot
8 attend the game, or is found to be in violation of the rules herein stated,
9 then that potential winner shall be disqualified, and another winner, time
10 permitting, shall be drawn from the lot.

11 4.2.5.1 If, any of the tickets are not claimed in a reasonable time before the
12 game, then the SGA President shall allocate the unclaimed tickets
13 to members of SGA.
14

29 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENTS OF OKLAHOMA STATE**
30 **UNIVERSITY BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION THAT:**
