    - 1. Some funding in leadership and campus life, how much we get in student fee allocations.
  - viii. Carmichael: Melisa position is funded through SGA?
    - 1. Yes, it's because of the history of the position.
  - ix. Kristen Martin: Hostile Amendment Explanation

1. Hoelting: Why is the OIL budget so much higher than the apportionments of the other budgets?
  - a. It looks a lot higher and that's because last year it was \$4,000 in their budget so it's still the same cut
2. Anderson: Is it in the authors opinion that some groups were removed but were not included in the budget?
  - a. Yes, but the 66% is those groups left in the budget
3. Debate on the Amendment
  - a. Dethloff: Motion to allow 2 speakers per side with 1 minute per speaker with yieldable time.

We need to make sure we are allocating funds where different student groups get those funds, that's why we have it set up that way. We want to make sure the future of SGA is spending money on programs that reach as many students as possible. While proportion makes sense, it doesn't reach the most amount of students.
