5 AS INTRODUCED
6

7 A recommendation calling for a 30-minute loading zone be added to Adam's Market; and
8 providing for forwarding:
9

10 **Whereas:** The Kerr-Drummond Mezzanine, where students can grocery shop, study, and eat
11 food, has a 30-minute loading zone.
12

13 **Whereas:** Adam's Market, another location on campus where students can grocery shop, study,
14 and eat food, does not have a 30-minute loading zone.
15

16 **Whereas:** Many students park directly in front of Adam's Market, which is a violation of up to
17 \$40, according to the Parking and Transportation Services at OSU.
18

19 **Whereas:** There is no indication on the curbside that shows parking directly in front of Adam's
20 Market is a violation, when numerous other areas on campus have a sign and/or
21 marking on the curb noting that parking there is not allowed.
22

23 THEREFORE, BE IT RECOMMENDED BY THE OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY
24 STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION THAT:
25

26 **Section 1:** Parking and Transportation Services add signs and/or markings to the area in front of
27 Adam's Market noting that parking there is not allowed at any time.
28

29 **Section 2:** Parking and Transportation Services shall also designate 3-5 parking spots as 30-
30 minute loading zones to be in one of two areas, 1) the residential spots in front of
31 Zink-Allen, or 2) convert the meters just east of Adam's Market to a loading zone, or
32 make the first 30 minutes free.
