9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENTS OF OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

11 **Section 1:** The purpose of the Oklahoma State Woodworking Club shall be to use our
12 talents to help the community through community service, decrease stress, and help
13 others who are interested to safely and successfully enter into the craft of woodworking.

7 A Recommendation to the Oklahoma State to adopt regulations to allow rentable electric
8 scooters to safely be on campus
9

10 WHEREAS: Much of the student body warmly received the electric scooters; and
11

12 WHEREAS: Within 24 hours of Oklahoma State announcing the ban the student body expressed
13 overwhelming uproar and displeasure towards the ban; and
14

15 WHEREAS: It is understood that the rentable electric scooters are considered a liability issue to
16 OSU due to the details of the contract between the rentable electric scooter companies and the
17 user/drive; and
18

19 WHEREAS: Rentable electric scooters have created a safety hazard on campus due to their high
20 speeds, no definitive parking procedure, and their blocking of walkways; and
21

22 WHEREAS: Other comparable universities have found a balance between their students' desire
23 for the electric scooters and preserving the safety and regulations of the school; and
24

25 WHEREAS: In June, the OSU/A&M Board of Regents approved a 3.2 percent increase
26 to tuition for fiscal year 2019, marking four straight years of increases that have made
27 educational costs for undergraduates 19.7 percent higher than that of 2015; and
28

29 WHEREAS: The rentable electric scooters brings a new mode of convenient, cost
30 effective transportation to the student body; and
31

32 WHEREAS: The OSU administration should prioritize collecting the student body's opinion and
33 continue to consider the student body's stance on the issue when deciding the course of action.

35 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT
36 GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION THAT:

38 Section 1: The OSU administration (and Parking and Transportation Services) work proactively
39 and cooperatively with both the City of Stillwater and the rentable electric scooter companies to
40 implement policies and procedure that ensure the safety of students and do not hold the

1 university responsible for incidents that may occur on university property; and

2
3 Section 2: The OSU administration (and Parking and Transportation Services) create parking
4 procedure and regulations for the rentable electric scooters on campus by designating areas to
5 park and by impounding any that infringe upon these regulations.
6

7 Section 3: The OSU administration (and Parking and Transportation Services) form “No-Ride
8 Zones” in high-traffic areas during high-traffic school hours
9
